Bush regeneration has focused on a waterfront site at Hurstville Grove removing lantana, privet and a severe infestation of ground asparagus weeds. Works have focused on regeneration of species in the intertidal and near-riparian zones with plant species of high salt tolerance.

In total 956 m² was worked.

Bush regeneration has focused on removal of severe lantana infestations in Riverside Park, Chipping Norton. The dense Lantana thicket has led to an explosion of Bell Miner bird population and associated Bell Miner die back of the Eucalypt canopy. The site has high native resilience to replace the Lantana with appropriate species. Works at Haigh Park involved removal of African Love Grass from the beach area, and at Bedwell Park removing Lantana and African Boxthorn.

In total 3,640 m² was worked.
